We especially encourage applications from prospective editorial teams.

To apply, please submit an application letter explaining why you are qualified for this position and any resources or support you envision needing and/or being able to arrange to help you with the work (release time, secretarial support, startup funds, etc.) and a current c.v. If you are proposing an editorial team, please provide background on all members and explain how they will work together on editing and production of the journal.
