Lodging

The Radisson University adjoins the University of Minnesota's Minneapolis campus and the campus town district known as Stadium Village, home to restaurants, coffeehouses, and bars. The conference rate is \$119 per night.

Attractions

On campus—the Weisman Art Museum, the Bell Museum of Natural History, and Walter and Wilson libraries all within easy walking distance.

Downtown Minneapolis—one mile to the west: the new Guthrie Theater, the Minnesota Center for Book Arts and Loft Literary Center, the Metrodome (home of the Minnesota Twins), the Mill City Museum, the new Cesar Pelli-designed Public Library, Nicollet Mall, restaurants, clubs, and art galleries.

Within a five mile radius—the Walker Art Center, the Minneapolis Institute of Art, Orchestra Hall, and the Minneapolis chain of lakes parks in Minneapolis; Como Park, Zoo and Conservatory, the Minnesota History Center, the Minnesota Children's Museum, and the Science Museum of Minnesota in St. Paul; and the Mall of America in Bloomington.
